

DANA CARGILE

Dana Cargile received her formal art education from Southwest Museum of Art in Midland, Baylor University, and workshops in Tyler, Houston and Mississippi.

She works as an art educator, an illustrator and a professional artist. She is regularly selected for juried art shows and is represented by The House of Wynne in Tyler. She has illustrated the childrens books "Pet Fairy," "The Art of Christmas," and "The Lost Bicycle." She has created art for national church bulletins distributed by Anchor Wallace Publications. Now living in Houston, Dana's new studio is located in The Silos at Sawyer Yards.

Christie Gunter Joy Art is an acrylic artist known for her Impasto Style. Her work is often referred to by collectors as "Happy Art" or "Art for the Senses." She has received many awards including Texas Rose Festival Queens Choice 2021 and 2024 and Peoples Choice of the Texas Rose Festival 2024.

Dace Kidd is a Latvian/American visual artist working primarily in the media of oil and acrylic on canvas. Dace (pronounced, "Dot-sa") completed her degree work at Art Academy of Latvia in Riga and received advanced training for two years at Accademia di belli Arti in Polermo.

After moving to the United States in 2011, she began creating murals and developed a portraiture style. She's had successful shows throughout Europe from Venice to Berlin to Amsterdam and exhibited artwork in New York City and Miami. She works on site-specific projects and regularly shows and curates art events in Tyler and Dallas.
