- 1. The Early Learning Institute: Continuing the 29 year history of Champions providing high quality child care training, the Early Learning Institute (ELI) will prioritize raising the quality of care that Texas children receive through Early Learning Programs. Last year, we provided over 18,000 certificate hours to Early Childhood Educators and will continue supporting teachers, staff, directors, and owners in building a strong early learning system.
- 2. Help Me Grow East Texas: All children benefit from an organized system of community resources to help them thrive. Help Me Grow East Texas provides developmental education, evidence-based screening and referrals, and ongoing support to families with young children. The program helps parents/caregivers address their questions and concerns about their child's development and works to provide nurturing environments where all children can learn. When confident and knowledgeable caregivers have the tools to understand their children's needs, they can better access the interventions that will have life-long impact in their children's lives.
